Before you can begin, you will need the following:

- Your library card number;
- Your library-issued PIN (contact your library if you don't have one);
- Check with the library to ensure you've been assigned the correct "patron type" so that you can access NNELS.

- 1. Go to nnels.ca
- 2. Click the "Sign up" button.
- 3. On the "Sign up with your local library" page, enter your library branch name, library system, or the city/town your library is located in, then click the "Search" button.
